The school will do its best to:

-  Provide an environment which has been risk assessed in response to the COVID-19 infection;
-  Adhere to the social distancing rules as set out by the government as much as we reasonably can;
-  Provide a curriculum that meets the needs of your child's well-being, mental health and academic needs;
-  Support your family and address any concerns you may have about your child's return to school;
-  Contact parents/carers if your child displays symptoms of COVID-19;
-  Inform you if staff or children in your child's registration group 'bubble' test positive with COVID-19 as this will mean you will all need to self-isolate for at least 14 days and home learning will be provided;
-  Continue our clear and consistent approach to rewards and sanctions for children as set out in the Behaviour Policy as well the expectations outlined in this agreement;
-  Communicate regularly between home and school through briefings, newsletters, text, email and the school website.

Parent

To help my child at school, I know and understand that:


-  If my child, or anyone in my household, shows symptoms of COVID-19, I will not send them to school, we will self-isolate as a family and I will get them tested immediately. I will let the school know as soon as possible via telephone;
-  When dropping off and picking up, I will strictly stick to the school timings for dropping off and collecting my child;
-  When dropping my child off and picking them up, I will adhere to the 2 metre social distancing rules and enter and leave the site quickly following the one-way system in place;
-  I will not enter the white box area at entrance points and will wave goodbye at that point;
-  My child must not bring any non-essential items into school with them. They will bring a named water bottle, lunch box and book bag;
-  My child will have their temperature taken during the day if they feel/present as being unwell;
-  I will need to remind my child about social distancing but accept they are difficult to follow and that my child may not always do this successfully;
-  My child will need to use good respiratory and hand hygiene;
-  I won't be allowed into the school unless by prior arrangement and should make contact via the office email;
-  I need to support all staff in their efforts to create an 'as safe as possible' environment;
-  Read all communications that are sent home;
-  I must ensure my contact details are correct and inform the school immediately of any changes to parents/carers and emergency contacts details;
-  If my child is deemed unsafe, he/she will be sent home and cannot return to school until they can be safe;

Child

I will do my best to:

-  Adhere to the social distancing rules in class and in the playground;
-  Tell an adult if I feel unwell;
-  Not bring things into school from home, or take things home from school;
-  Only use the equipment provided to me by school and no other;
-  Not mix with any other children in the school;
-  Only enter and exit the school building from the designated gate using the one-way system;
-  Follow good respiratory hygiene: coughing and sneezing into elbow or tissue (catch it-bin it-kill it);
-  Follow good hand hygiene – use soap and water for 20 seconds/ hand sanitiser;
-  Behave well at all times to maintain the safety of myself and others;
-  Follow these expectations and know that if I don't, I will be sent home and will not be able to come back into school until I can be safe.
