Literacy

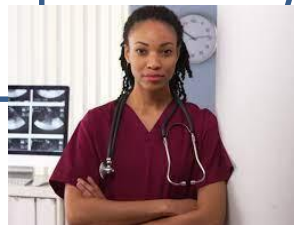
- Writing sentences, simple stories, reports concentrating on finger spaces, full stops and capital letters
