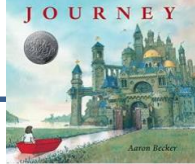
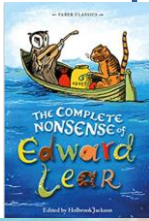


English

Y4

Science

- Recognise that they need light in order to see things, darkness is the absence of light and sunlight can be dangerous
- Notice that light is reflected
- Recognise that shadows are formed and find patterns in the way that the size of shadows change.
- Identify how sounds are made and recognise that vibrations from sounds travel through a medium to the ear.
- Find patterns between the pitch and volume of a sound
- Recognise that sounds get fainter as the distance from the sound source increases.

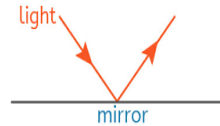
