Dear Families,

**Change to Drop off times**

After half term all children need to arrive at school between 8.40am and 8.55am. Please continue to maintain social distance between families, wear face masks, use the one-way systems and enter and exit the playground swiftly. Our aim is to revise pick up times in June after government guidance has been released for the national roadmap.

However, in the meantime please continue to pick up at the staggered times allocated to your child's registration group.

Pick up and drop off zone will continue to be available for those that need to use it. To help reduce emissions please can you turn off your engines whilst waiting.

**Face masks**

To continue to minimise the risk of infection we advise that all adults should, where possible, continue to wear face masks whilst on the school site. Thank you.
